- **1.2** No work will be carried out by any of our cleaners who has coronavirus symptoms, however mild, or when someone in their own household has the symptoms.
- **1.3** No work would be carried out in any household which is isolating or where an individual is being shielded.

2. Our Cleaners Responsibilities:

- **2.1:** All our cleaners have been advised to stagger their start times to avoid the morning rush hour traffic.
- **2.2:** All cleaners will wear their PPE's of Disposable Aprons and Gloves.
- **2.3:** All cleaners have been instructed to put their outside clothing in a plastic bag, which the cleaners will bring with them and the clothing left in the hallway.
- **2.4:** All cleaners footwear will be left by the front door. A separate pair of rubber soled socks or slippers will be worn around your home.
- **2.5:** Cleaners will wash their hands when entering a home or office using soap and water for 20 seconds and throughout the cleaning process.
- 2.6: To prevent the spread of the Corona virus we will be introducing a new Natural Disinfectant from Delphis Eco at a cost of £4.00 for a 1-litre bottle (This product prevent cross contamination and protect all surfaces. It is highly effective against a wide range of micro-organisms to stop the spread of harmful infection, and kills 99.999% of germs and bacteria.)
